The Eligibility Requirements for VPK:

Children must live in Florida and be 4 years old on or before September 1 of the current year to be eligible. Families with children born between February 2 and September 1 have the option to postpone enrolling their 4-year-old until the following year when their child is 5.

To Apply for VPK Certificate of Eligibility:



Once you application is approved, the coalition will provide you with a Certificate of Eligibility.

PROGRAM BACKGROUND:

The Voluntary Prekindergarten Education (VPK) program was created in 2005 to prepare every four-year-old for kindergarten and continued educational success. The VPK program helps each child build a strong foundation through appropriate curricula.

PROGRAM OPTIONS:

School-Year Session:

- 540 instructional hours that include 3 hours of daily instruction PLUS a parent fee for afternoon services.
- Full Day School-Year Session- only at select sites 540 instructional hours that include 3 hours of daily instruction PLUS enrichment.
- Full Day School-Year Session Blended Class
 540 instructional hours that include 3 hours of daily instruction provided by an Exceptional
 Student Education Teacher.

Summer Session:

300 instructional hours and classes do not exceed 12 students
