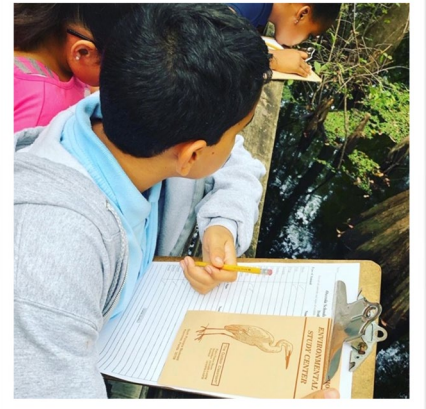
The Center, located on a section of the Reedy Creek Swamp, serves as an educational resource for Osceola County students. The Center features two classroom buildings where students have the opportunity to engage in scientific investigations and an up-close observation of the region's natural history on display. A raised walkway gives students access to a Cypress Swamp filled with flora and fauna such as alligators, tree frogs, 400-year-old cypress trees, native plants and a variety of birds. On weekends, the center is open to the public 10:00 am to 5:00 pm on Saturdays and on Sundays from noon to 5:00 pm.
