<p style="text-align: center;"><b>DRESS CODE</b> <b><u>FS 1006.07 (2d1&amp;2)</u></b> <b>(State Required Consequences)</b></p> <p>A student, while on the grounds of a public school during the regular school day, shall not wear clothing that exposes underwear or body parts in an indecent or vulgar manner or that disrupts the orderly learning environment.</p> <p>More information regarding dress code policy and consequences can be found in the Dress Code section of this document and in the opening of the Behavior Matrix section of this document.</p>	<p>Mandatory</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Parent/Guardian Contact</li> <li>• Conference with Student</li> </ul> <p>Based on Severity</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Change of Clothes</li> </ul> <p>*Teacher response to misbehavior should align with individual School-Based Tier 1 Behavior Plan. If you are unsure, consult with site administration.</p>	<p>Mandatory</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A verbal warning, and the school administration shall call the student’s parent or guardian.</li> </ul>	<p>Mandatory</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The student is ineligible to participate in any extracurricular activity for a period of time not to exceed 5 days and the school administration shall meet with the student’s parent or guardian.</li> </ul>	<p>Mandatory</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• In-school suspension for a period not to exceed 3 days, the student is ineligible to participate in any extracurricular activity for a period not to exceed 30 days, and the school administration shall call the student’s parent or guardian and send the parent or guardian a written letter regarding the student’s in-school suspension and ineligibility to participate in extracurricular activities.</li> </ul>
